

### 6.3.3 Colorado DOT's Roadway Geodatabase – Project Stopped

**Co-Presenter**

Since 2002, the Colorado Dept. of Transportation (CDOT) needed a new roadway data model for editing roadway inventory and geographic data, integrating current attribute data into that model, and generating and publishing linear referenced roadway data. In May 2007, this project was stopped! All CDOT participants agreed to this decision. This presentation covers the reasons why CDOT devised this project and the fundamental goals and business conditions that underlay it. This talk focuses on: what changed about CDOT's goals and business conditions; what discoveries did we make about our abilities; what technologies and tools changed in our roadway editing processes. Finally, this presentation covers the concerns and findings from 2007 that finally brought us to stop the project.
