The Michigan State GIO office (Center for Shared Solutions or CSS) and MDOT has had a close and productive relationship since the mid-1990's in creating a common transportation GIS framework and Linear Referencing System (LRS). The first part of this presentation will cover a brief history of the 15+ year partnership and some of the key success factors and return-on-investments (ROI's) that have contributed to this strong relationship. The second part of the presentation will provide an update on the latest efforts to improve the transportation GIS/LRS data stewardship process by involving not only all road agencies in the state, but also the 911 community as well. A few GIS-T application examples will be provided that further demonstrate the value of a strong collaborative transportation data stewardship program.
